

What is Shopmobility?

Shopmobility is an important service within our community, offering people with a disability, impairment, injury or illness, whether permanent or temporary, the opportunity to hire manual or powered wheelchairs and a variety of scooters.

You can use **Shopmobility** to go into the Town centre shopping areas or to the General Hospital by means best suited to you. You can either hire a manual wheelchair or, to be completely independent, a scooter or electric wheelchair.



How does this Service Work?

You may use the service as often as you wish subject to equipment being available

The Shopmobility Co-ordinator will help you to select the equipment best suited to your individual needs and preferences.

If using a powered wheelchair for the first time you will be given a short training session which will ensure that you can use it safely.

Additional equipment like leg extensions, right or left hand controls, cushions, and blankets are available

How Can I Join?

When you arrive you will be asked to complete a registration form and to show proof of your identity and home address. A membership card will be issued which will need to be produced each time you use the service

What Does it Cost?

There is no membership fee and Members are charged £2:00p per session.

Non members and visitors are charged £3:00p per session

Proof of identity or a membership card must be produced for all hires

Manual Wheelchair Hire

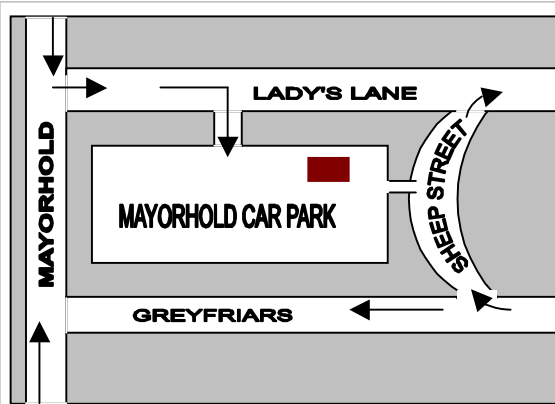
Shopmobility can also supply manual wheelchairs for long term hire for up to 8 weeks. Both small wheel and self propelled wheelchairs of various sizes, including children's, are available.

There is a returnable deposit of £25 and two proofs of identity and address are required with a donation of £1 per day.
